The following is a statement all Deacons sign when they begin a new term of service:

### STATEMENT OF MY COMMITMENT UPON BEING AN ACTIVE DEACON

**Deacons of First Baptist Jackson are first and foremost servants. The New Testament Greek word “diakonos”, which is transliterated in our English Bibles as “Deacon”, is simply and wonderfully the Greek word for “Servant”.**

Having been nominated by the Deacon Nominating Committee to become an active Deacon, beginning in January 1, 2021, I have examined myself and have sought the Lord's leadership, and agree to allow my name to be presented to the Church for consideration in selecting me as a Deacon for an active term in this Church, and in doing so:

- *I believe in, and am relying upon, the Lord Jesus Christ as my personal Savior.*
- *I understand that in God's Holy Scriptures, the word Deacon means “servant” and as a Deacon of First Baptist Jackson, I will strive to serve our Lord and His church in every way I can.*
- *I will earnestly seek the Lord's direction in every area of my life, including the use of my time, my material possessions, my unique abilities, and my influence to both serve the Lord and project a positive Christian example in His Kingdom here on earth and through this Church.*
- *I will continuously examine the quality of my spiritual life to assure that I walk in the light as He is in the light at all times. In so doing, I will endeavor to avoid sin at every turn and, as needed, seek forgiveness and repent as Christ commanded.*
- *I will also take care that, in exercising my personal freedom, I do not become a stumbling block to other brothers and sisters, so that I may live in continuous fellowship with Him.*
- *I will faithfully support the budget of this church as a practicing tither and will give to His church as the Holy Spirit directs.*

- *I recognize that the great commission of my Lord Jesus Christ is to reach the lost people of the world, and as a Deacon of First Baptist Jackson, I commit to use my abilities to accomplish this commission through personal prayer, Bible study, and personal involvement to reach the lost.*
- *I will make a consistent effort to regularly attend the Deacons' meetings each month and carry out any committee assignments.*
- *I commit to the following Scriptural requirements to serving as a Deacon:*

***1 Timothy 3:8-11 - “Deacons, likewise, are to be men worthy of respect, sincere, not indulging in much wine, and not pursuing dishonest gain. They must keep hold of the deep truths of the faith with a clear conscience. They must first be tested; and then if there is nothing against them, let them serve as Deacons. In the same way, their wives are to be women worthy of respect, not malicious talkers but temperate and trustworthy in everything.” (NIV)***
